**Please put all these in your recycling sack or smart bank:**



✓ Paper, card and cardboard



✓ Glass bottles and jars



✓ Plastic bottles, pots, tubs and trays



✓ Cartons



✓ Cans and tins

**Please ensure all items are clean and dry**



**Please don't put these in your recycling sack or smart bank:**



✗ Shredded paper



✗ Aerosols



✗ Hard plastics and soft plastics



✗ Food waste



✗ Clothes and textiles

✗ Any items not ticked in green  
✗ Nappies  
✗ Electricals and cables  
✗ Wood  
✗ Metal items  
✗ DIY materials  
✗ Polystyrene  
✗ Foil

## Recycle that lid!

- **Plastic?** Squeeze air out of the bottle and replace the lid
- **Metal?** Please put these in loose



## Aerosols? No can do

For safety reasons, we're no longer recycling aerosol cans.

If you've got cans to get rid of, please put them in your general waste.



# How to recycle: kerbside collections

If your rubbish and recycling is collected from the kerbside, then we provide you with free, clear recycling bags.

**Place your full bag** of recycling out at the same time as your general waste.

# How to recycle: estates and large blocks of flats

If you live on an estate or in a large block of flats, then you will have access to large, shared recycling bins (smart banks).

Use your reusable recycling bag to take your recycling to the nearest recycling bin. Empty it loose into the bin.
