# **Annual Heating Switch-Off**

- Roof street stairs and railings will not require scaffolding or access.

#### Gardens

- The Colet Gardens pedestrian entranceway has been refurbished and plants transferred to form a hedge around the rose garden near Block 1.
- A plant bed near Block 1, has been extended and a new bed near Block 3C is being prepared for planting,
- A new Liquidambar tree has been planted on the green.

# Kids on Playing, Roller Skates & Scooters
