Estate Office Festive Opening Hours:

Monday 25th December 2023 (Christmas Day) = Office is closed. Tuesday 26th December 2023 (Boxing Day) = Office is closed. Wednesday 27th December 2023 = Office is open 8:30am to 4:30pm. Thursday 28th December 2023 = Office is open 8:30am to 4:30pm. Friday 29th December 2023 = Office is open 8:30am to 1pm. Monday 1st January 2024 (New Years Day) = Office is closed. - It's not obstructing the pavement or any road.
- > All decorations and pots have been removed from the tree.
